## **EXPLORE THE TEXT**

Revelation 4:6, 8

John was caught up into heaven, where he saw a vision of God Almighty on his throne. There all of Christ's followers and the heavenly angels were worshipping God. The four living creatures in this passage represent the qualities and character of God. They guard God's throne, lead others in worship, and proclaim God's holiness. All creatures in heaven and earth fall down in worship, because God is the Creator and Sustainer of everything.

2. Why is God's holiness central to worship?		
3. How can you more fully submit to God in worship?

2. Why is it important to recall Christ's sacrifice when we worship?
3. How does this passage inspire you or give you hope?

## **EXAMINE YOURSELF**
